ANNUAL REPORT 2013-14

Respected President of the function and Secretary of the College Managing Committee **Shri Dr.T.R.Dhinakaran**, revered Chief Guest **Thiru A. It is my pleasure to present the 44th Annual Report of our College for the Academic year 2013-2014.

Our College was started in 1970 with 7 teachers and 84 students. Now it has grown into a first grade autonomous college with a total student strength of 3341 (885 boys and 2456 girls), 122 members of the teaching staff and 53 members of the non-teaching staff. It became autonomous in 2010-11 and was reaccredited with 'A' grade by NAAC in April 2012. Now our college has 12 U.G. courses, 8 P.G. courses, 2 M.Phil courses, 2 Ph.D Programmes, 7 Diploma and 4 Certificate courses. From the next academic year onwards M.Phil., Computer Science course has been approved for commencement in our college.

Faculty Improvement and Career Development

Ms.R.Poongothai of Tamil department, Mr.P. Gurusamy of Chemistry, Major.R.Sivasubramanian of Commerce, Mr.K. Arunesh of Computer Science, Ms.R. Revathi, of History, Ms.R. Sridevi of Mathematics, Ms.S. Elizabeth Prema Latha of Physics, Mr.K. Selvaraj of Botany and Mr.S. Nattar, Librarian were awarded Ph.D., degree in this academic year.

In the National Seminar organized by the Global Economic Progress and Research Association, Bangaluru, Dr.S. Jeyakumar Assistant Professor in Commerce was awarded Rajiv Gandhi Gold Medal Award for Excellence.

Mrs.R. Mahalakshmi of Nutrition and Dietetics Department passed UGC Net Examination in June 2013.

Research and Development

Out of the sanctioned amount of Rs.70,00,000/- the 1st installment amount Rs.22,50,000/- has been received under FIST programme. The amount has been utilised for the purchase of equipment to improve the infrastructure of the Science departments.

Besides PG department of Commerce, PG Department of Mathematics has also been upgraded as a research department. During this academic year (2013-14),

two research scholars were awarded Ph.D., in commerce under the guidance of Dr.A. Subbiah of our college.

One candidate obtained Ph.D., degree under the supervision of Dr.S. Murugesan, Associate Prof. in Mathematics. In the department of Mathematics, 13 candidates are doing Ph.D and 13 research articles have been published at National and International journals.

The faculty members of other departments also are guiding M.Phil and Ph.D., scholars and have published research articles in reputed journals and attended, national and international conferences also.

Faculty members of UG physics department have presented 6 research articles at national and international conferences.

The faculty members of the history department have presented papers at 4 national and 3 international conferences.

Computer science faculty presented a paper at International conference and published research article in international journal.

IQAC

IQAC of our college has conducted one Orientation Programme for the young teachers and one retraining programme for all faculty members. Another orientation programme was also conducted for the Non-teaching staff. Dr.Ma.Paa. Gurusamy, Secretary, Gandhi Museum, Madurai, Dr.S. Sankarrajan Director, Fragarhan's Academy, Chennai, Dr.S. Jeyaraman, VHNSN College and Dr. Manohar of ANJA College were the resource persons.

Scholarship

Three research scholars were awarded scholarships to a sum of Rs.76,500/- from various governmental organisations for the year 2013-14. We are yet to receive other scholarships also for this year.

- Dr.G.Veerakumaran Endowment cash prize of Rs.1000/- is awarded every year to the student who secures the first place in M.Phil commerce.
- Thiru.P.Madhavan Memorial Endowment Prize was instituted by his son Mr.M.Sundarajan, one of the first batch (1983-1985) of M.Com students. A cash prize of Rs.5000/- is awarded to the students who secure first place and Rs.2500/- to the students who secure second place in B.Com., B.Com., (C.A) and M.Com.
- Prof. Ramamoorthi – Michigan University, USA, old student of Chemistry has donated Rs.50,000/-
- Gold medals are being awarded every year to the Best Boy student and the Best Girl student by Sri.T.G.Krishnamoorthy, a Chennai-based industrialist. A gold medal for the Most Pious student is awarded by Sri Sai Pathuga Trust, Madurai every year.

Infrastructure

To fulfill the class room requirements of all the courses, our management has arranged to construct additional buildings this year.

Our college has the facilities like a fulltime Health Care Centre, a canteen, a store, two generators with 125 KVA capacity each, a well-equipped Indoor Stadium, Spacious Auditorium, a well furnished Guest House, Internet connectivity to all departments, a Browsing Centre, and IGNOU Study Centre.

There are separate hostels in our college for both boys and girls. 105 boys stay in the Boys Hostel and 462 girls stay in the Girls Hostel. A Team of Resident wardens headed by the Deputy Warden Dr.N. Soundararaj is maintaining the hostels in a good manner. The monthly mess bill is calculated on the basis of dividing system.

Physics alumni endowment has earned an amount of Rs.9000/- in this academic year for its endowment.
