It is my pleasure to present the 43rd Annual Report of our College for the year 2012-2013.

Our College was started in 1970 with 7 teachers and 84 students. Now it has grown into a first grade autonomous college with a total student strength of 3091 (892 boys and 2199 girls), 121 members of the teaching staff and 53 members of the non-teaching staff. It became autonomous in 2010-11 and was reaccredited with 'A' grade by NAAC in April 2012. Now our college has 10 U.G. courses and 6 P.G. courses and 2 M.Phil courses 1 Ph.D Programme, 7 Diploma and 4 Certificate courses

Hostel

There are separate hostels in our college for both boys and girls. 204 boys stay in the Boys Hostel and 460 girls stay in the Girls Hostel. A Team of Resident wardens headed by the Deputy Warden Dr.S.Venkatasamy is maintaining the hostels in a good manner. The monthly mess bill is calculated on the basis of dividing system.

Physical Education
